#### **Rules and Regulations**

- 1. The Miss Medford Participation will take place virtually, with crowning to take place at the Opening Ceremony on Thursday June 17<sup>th</sup> at 6pm.
- 2. Deadline for sign up is May 30th, 2021. Please submit all required items by this date.
- 3. Contestants must currently attend Medford School. Tiny Miss Contestants must plan to attend Medford School in the future.
- 4. There will be no limit of contestants this year. If some age brackets have less participation, age brackets may be adjusted to try to accommodate more contestants.
- 5. Miss Medford Candidates: If selected you will be expected to volunteer for Medford community events throughout the year, including Straight River Days events, Easter Egg Hunt, and assist with the next years pageant. These events are still being finalized.
- 6. Contestants must send in the completed registration form and \$20 registration fee to apply. An acceptance letter will be emailed once you have been accepted into the pageant, with further instructions pertaining to the candidate's bracket.
- 7. This year we will be requiring electronic video submissions, as well as photo submissions. Directions on submission guidelines can be found on the Straight River Days website. Be sure to submit all requirements to qualify.

### **Judging:**

- 1. Contestants are encouraged to submit their video in formal wear. Attire should be a dress that is flattering to the contestant and age appropriate. Candidates that do not adhere to age appropriate attire will not be allowed to participate. If you do not have a dress available to you, please contact straightriverdayspageant@gmail.com, as we have access to dresses in a variety of sizes to use for the event.
- 2. Contestants will be judged on natural beauty, over all personality and comfort on camera. We encourage each applicant to show their personality as best as possible on camera. Excessive make up is not encouraged.
- 3. No individual score sheets will be issued. The decision of the judges is final and will not be questioned.
- 4. There will be 5 different age groups this year. All Tiny and Little will be crowned. Only the winner of Young Miss and JR miss will be crowned (there will not be a runner up in these categories). The top 3 contestants in the Miss Medford category will be crowned, and finally a Miss Congeniality will receive a sash.
- 5. Unsportsmanlike conduct will not be tolerated by contestants, parents, or any audience that may be in attendance during crowning. Please be aware that rude or unsportsmanlike conduct or comments from the family or supporters will result in immediate disqualification of the contestant.

All rules and regulations are the same for all age groups.

Rules may be subject to change.

Crowing will take place during the opening ceremony and contestants are encouraged to "dress to impress"! NO formalwear is needed, but your favorite summer dress is encouraged.

The <u>Queens</u> for each bracket will have a float in the Straight River Days Parade on Friday night June 18<sup>th</sup>, 2021 and are encouraged to wear their dress and crown.
