Medford Parade Information 2021—June 18th, 2021.

5:30pm line up and 7pm start.

Parade Route: As you may have noticed on the previous page, the route is still “to be determined”. Medford has several updating projects underway; which is giving us a little bump in the road. The lineup area that we have used the last 30 years is no longer available and we have a main street project that is affecting the route for the next couple of years. Please provide your email address as that is how entries will be notified with the new map or line up location as well as the route.

Drop off area: This is extra important this year because of the new lineup location and because of the new route. Please arrange for your group or unit to have an alternate meeting place for the float riders/ walkers to meet. From there, once your unit is complete, head to the lineup. This will make the lineup go much smoother and we will have less traffic at the start. PLEASE PASS THIS ONTO THE RIDERS ON YOUR FLOAT. ESPICALLY TEAMS!

Misc info:

- The line up is going to be first come first serve.
- Only parade units are allowed to be in the lineup rows. We do prefer you to use an alternate spot for vehicles.
- Please bring something to drink as it is hot and there is limited shade.
- All units must be self-insured.
- Units with animals must provide your own pooper scoopers.
- Units should pick up the garbage etc. in their area before they start the parade route.

Safety: *New this year* Please be respectful when throwing candy from moving vehicles and floats. We prefer for you to have walkers to hand items directly to the crowd.

- No one under age 15 should hand out candy without adult supervision.
- Any unit in violation may not be invited to future parades.

Spacing: Please help us avoid gaps in the parade. Keep a safe distance between you and the entry in front of you. Keep the pace with the entry in front of you, not the pace of your walkers.

Our parade is a fantastic one and we have hundreds of people attend! What is going to make your entry memorable?? Some suggestions are lots and lots of candy, coolies, shirts, beads, music, dancing....even handing out coupons!!--- The possibilities are endless! Have fun!
